OLB is currently the ONLY Catholic childcare in the diocese! The demand for quality infant and toddler care is high. Many programs in the Columbus area have a wait list of a year or longer (especially for infant care). OLB has started a capital campaign to raise funds for needed renovations to our convent/residence area, which will house infant and toddler classrooms, a family room and a nap room. The first phase of the campaign involved seeking donations from companies, organizations and individuals with a prior history of giving to OLB. This phase has raised almost \$120,000. In the months ahead, OLB will work with area schools and parishes to raise awareness of our new and existing programs. We will also continue our efforts in raising additional funds to complete renovations and open the infant and toddler program sometime this year.
