● **T 7/20; Grades 4-8 “Back to the Wilderness” Campout**

-A signed permission slip is needed for this event.

-Campers are welcome to stay after childcare that day or leave at their normal time & come back for the campout that evening.

-Miss Lori, Miss Sherri & Mr. MacGregor, Miss Breanna & Miss Miranda will be spending the night. Other teachers will also be in attendance throughout the evening.

-Parents are welcome & encouraged to attend the campout. We ask that you let us know ahead of time so we can plan for enough food & include you in events. If we do not have your fingerprint report & “Protecting God’s Children” certificate on file, you may only be in a tent with your own child.

-Campers are asked to bring the following items for the campout:

-Sleeping bag & pillow

-Duffel bag to hold:

-Spare clothing, including tennis shoes

-Personal hygiene items such as soap, shampoo, toothbrush/paste, towel, etc.

-Flashlight w/batteries

-Glow stick (can be purchased at most stores in the camping section)

-Insect repellent

-White t-shirt or other white item (such as socks) for splatter painting activity

-Camp chair or folding chair (for sitting around the campfire)

-Students are not permitted to bring cell phones or pagers to the campout. They will have complete access to OLB’s land line & Miss Lori’s cell phone in the event they want to call you. You can reach us or your child at any time by calling (614)208-0605.

-The campout is rain or shine. If it is raining, we will campout inside the building.

- Groups follow their regular schedules until 11:15 pm, when lunch, recess & changing into swimwear begins.
- Students in every group travel to Tremont Pool by bus.
- Students should wear their normal clothes to OLB that day.

- Students apply sunscreen before departing OLB. Water bottles & sunscreen are taken to the pool.
- Departure from OLB is 12:30 pm. Return is approximately 3:15 pm.**
